**Have you gotten the ACT score you need to enter the college of your choice?** If not, the next test date is April 8, 2017. The final day to register is March 3, 2017. You must register online at [www.actstudent.org](http://www.actstudent.org). If you are on free or reduced lunch and have not used your 2 waivers, you must register then come see me for the waiver number. Be sure you put the 4 colleges you want your scores sent to.

**Have you applied to your selected college?** If not, do so ASAP. Go to that school's web site for online registration. If you want to know who the recruiter for our area is, that information is available on the school web site. When you get your acceptance letter, bring it to me along with a small picture and I will copy it and post it on the "I'm Going to College" bulletin board.

**How about scholarships?** Attached is a list of scholarships you can apply for. Notice the deadlines. Contact the college that has accepted you and see if there are any scholarships available for you. **Be sure you have filed your FAFSA.**

**School is not over until May 5, 2017. Remember every assignment, project and test is important. Some points are better than none. A zero can only hurt you. Meet with your teachers if you are having trouble. Use [homeworkla.org](http://homeworkla.org) for extra help and tutoring—it works!**

### **1) AIS Scholarships - \$10,000 - 35 Awards (Deadline: February 15, 2017)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Enrolled in a university, college, junior college or technical school
- B) One-Quarter (1/4) enrolled member of a Federally Recognized Native American Tribe

### **2) Elks National Foundation Scholarship - \$4,000 - 250 Awards (Deadline: February 3, 2017)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) The student must complete and submit the ONLINE application. The 2017 Legacy Awards application deadline is due online by 12:00 p.m. (noon) Central Time on Friday, February 3, 2017.
- B) Upon receipt of the application, the applicant will receive a notification that the application was received. Winners will be announced in late April 2017.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) At least 13 years old and enrolled or will enroll in a college or university in the US.
- B) A legal resident of the U.S. or Puerto Rico.

**4) 2017 Scholarship Points Awards - \$10,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: January 31, 2017)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) At least 13 years old and enrolled or will enroll in a college or university in the US.
- B) A legal resident of the U.S. or Puerto Rico.

- A) No minimum GPA or essay required. This \$5,000 easy scholarship is open to people ages 13 to 25. You must also live in the U.S. or have U.S citizenship.

**6) John and Muriel Landis Scholarships - \$1,000 - 9 Awards (Deadline: February 1, 2017)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Any high school senior who is a citizen of the United States is eligible to apply.
- B) Applicants need not be related to a member of the Elks.
