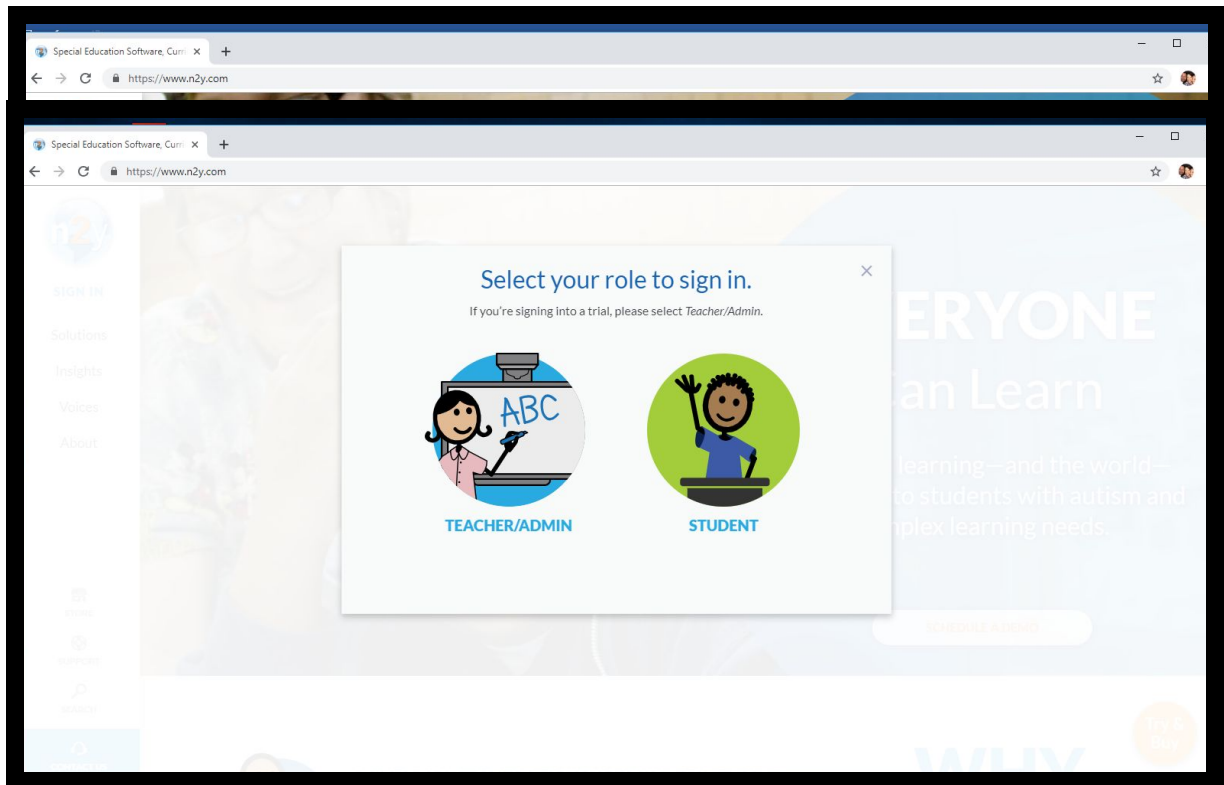


# Using Unique at Home: Teacher Instructions for Creating QR Codes

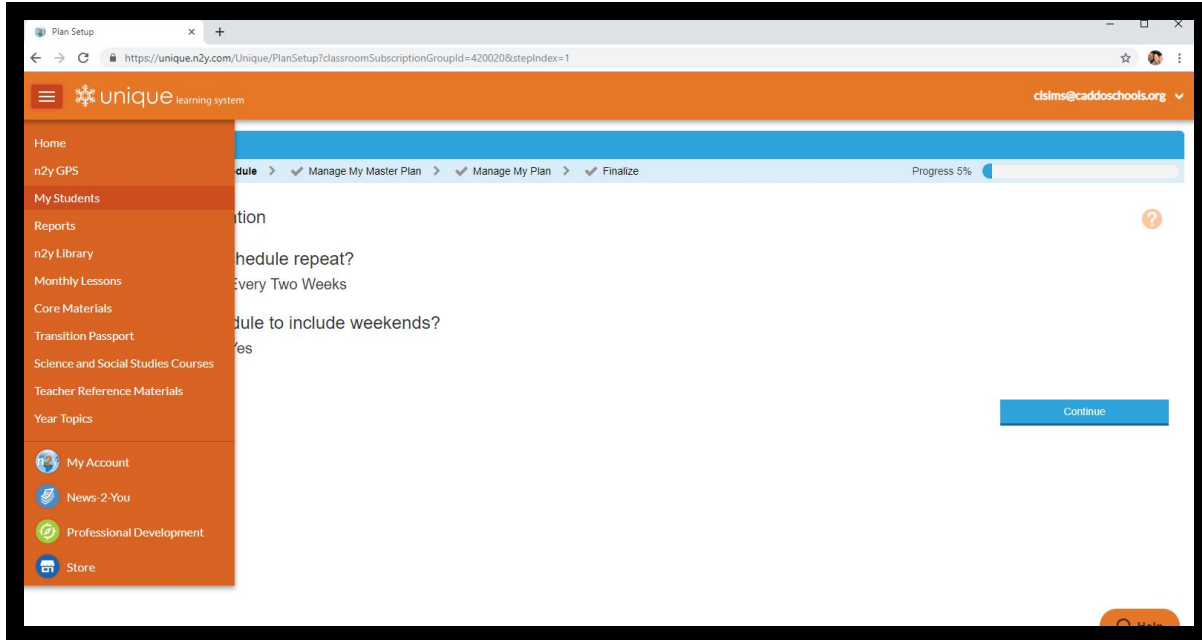

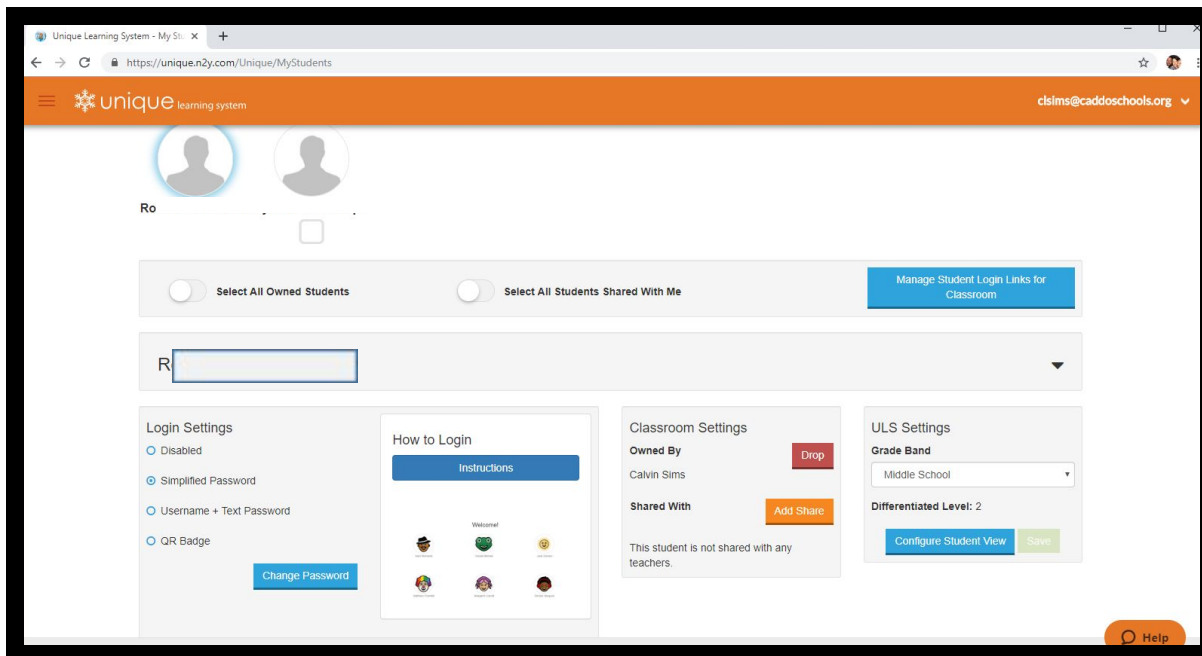

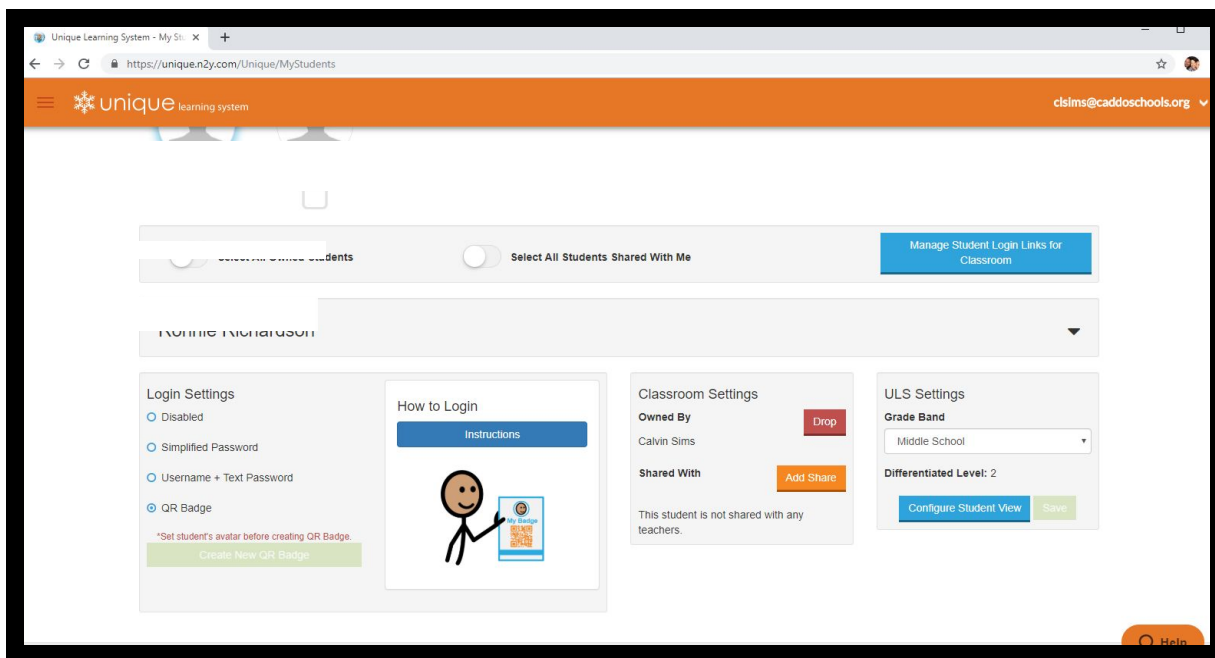
7. Select the student you want to create a QR Code for.
